

The following information is provided to clarify membership levels. If you have any questions, please contact info@ntba.net.

1. If you have ever been a member of the NTBA, either a current or past member, then please mark yourself as a RENEWING member. NEW members are those who have never joined the NTBA previously.
2. If you are a developer, meaning you have RISK and OWNERSHIP in a project or company that develops new urban projects, then you are a TOWN FOUNDER MEMBER. If you are a partner or an employee of a TOWN FOUNDER who has a current membership, then you may join at a reduced rate as an ASSOCIATE MEMBER. You must indicate the primary member's name in order to join as a secondary member. Do not use the ASSOCIATE MEMBER category if you do not have a primary Town Founder with a current membership.
3. If you are a consultant to the new urban industry, perhaps as a master planner, architect, marketing firm, or sales consultant, you may join as an AFFILIATED PROFESSIONAL MEMBER. Please indicate your specialty. Subsequent employees of a current AFFILIATED PROFESSIONAL MEMBER may join at a reduced rate under the ASSOCIATE MEMBER category. Do not use the ASSOCIATE MEMBER category if you do not have a primary AFFILIATED PROFESSIONAL MEMBER with a current membership. AFFILIATED PROFESSIONAL members and associates must be approved by the Board of Directors.
4. If you are in the new urban development industry and are 35 years or younger in 2020, you may join as a NEXT GEN MEMBER.
5. If you are a government employee, such as a city manager or city planner OR you work for a non-profit entity such as a foundation, you may join as a NON-PROFIT MEMBER.

Membership & Roundtables:

Spouses or significant others who are in the new urban profession must have a current NTBA membership to attend the Roundtables. Spouses or significant others who are not in our industry may purchase a Roundtable guest registration without being a member.

Associate members who cannot attend a Roundtable, may send a substitute in their place without purchasing an additional membership.
